



TIEBREAK PROCEDURES

Match Play

Any match that is all square after 18 holes is to be immediately extended in sudden death format beginning with hole number one. (Or, in the event the match started on a different hole, the playoff should begin on that hole.) Prior to teeing off at the first hole, competitors must check with the pro shop and coordinate their play so as to avoid interfering with scheduled tee times. Note that in accordance with [USGA Rules](#), extra holes played in this fashion are an extension of the original match and do not constitute a separate match. All strokes that applied in the original match will apply on the playoff hole(s).

Stroke Play

When two or more competitors (players or teams) are tied for first place in a stroke play event, the outright winner will be determined by matching cards according to the following procedure. For handicap events, this procedure refers to the net scores after strokes have been applied individually to appropriate holes.

1. The winner shall be the competitor with the lower aggregate score for holes 10 through 18.
2. If the competitors have identical scores for holes 10 through 18, the winner shall be the competitor with the lower aggregate score for holes 13 through 18.
3. If the competitors have identical scores for holes 13 through 18, the winner shall be the competitor with the lower aggregate score for holes 16 through 18.
4. If the competitors have identical scores for holes 16 through 18, the winner shall be the competitor with the lower score for hole number 18.
5. If the competitors have identical scores for hole number 18, the winner shall be determined by matching cards in sudden death fashion, beginning with the number one handicap hole, and proceeding in order through the number 18 handicap hole.
6. In the unlikely event that a winner has still not been determined. The competitors shall be declared co-winners, and total winnings for first and second place shall be divided equally.

Note that this procedure will only be used to resolve a first place winner for each flight. Ties for other places will remain, and total winnings for the affected places shall be divided equally among those tied.

Also note that if more than two competitors are tied for first place, the above procedure will only be used to determine the outright winner. Once a winner is determined, the remaining competitors will automatically be declared tied for second place.
